- **SBSTA agenda item 10(a):** Methodological issues under the Kyoto Protocol on carbon dioxide capture and storage;

And, jointly with the SBI:

• **SBSTA agenda item 7:** Forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures.

The SBI Chair and myself are consulting bilaterally and holding informal consultations with interested Parties to further discussions on issues as much as possible.
