 - Date of arrival in Thailand

Upon receipt of this information the Thai authorities will provide you with the relevant confirmation regarding your visa for Thailand. Please note that the Thai authorities require this information at least seven days before the date of departure from your country. Failure to provide this information could result in visas not being granted or not issued in a timely manner.
