### 11 December 2014, 18:00

Dear ministers, colleagues, ladies and gentlemen, thank for being at the meeting.

We are in the crucial moment to make decisions.

As the president of the COP, I have a strong message to you to give a guidance to move this process move forward.

We do not want to leave Lima with empty hands. We want to leave with the achievement. We are not in the time of one place. We are on the road towards Paris.

Show your confidence for the coordination seeking compromise. Focus on the key issues for substantial discussions. With the confidence in key points, we can work in an efficient way. Not in the words, not in the commas, not in the dots, but in the substance. If we have the text, under my guidance, with the key points, we can work in a very effective and efficient way.

We need to show we can advance, by bringing reasonable text tonight. Start work immediately, and report back on time as you announced.

Ministers share with me their best sense on common ground to take further decisions. This is crucial in this task, as we share what we would like to have at the end of this sCOP20/MOP10: clear decisions on INDC, clear update from the previous COPs, produce the document for 2015 agreement.

We need to send a good signal to the citizens.
