- Let me be very brief. Differentiation is a key political issue that pervades the entire structure of the proposed Agreement.
- We've been having a series of bilateral consultations throughout the day and it is very clear that the fault lines remain. We will be working with Presidency and secretariat tonight to crystalize in the text that will be presented tomorrow the fault lines and leave the choice to the Parties.
- Quite frankly, at this point in time, Parties are not yet ready to place their final positions on the table. We will continue to do these consultations later this evening and subsequently tomorrow after the text is published.
