**Annex [x] The Warsaw Platform on Effective Climate Finance**

*The Conference of the Parties,*

*Recalling* Articles 4 and 11 of the Convention,

*Also recalling* decisions 1/CP.13, 1/CP.16, 2/CP.17, 3/CP.17 and 1/CP.18

*Noted* that effective climate finance is achieved through a three-way partnership to ensure the interests of recipients, donors, and public and private-sector finance providers are mutually understood and well aligned;

*Further noted* that, to deliver effective mitigation and adaptation outcomes and achieve the partnership referred to above, climate finance from whichever sources should:

- i) Encourage and support Parties to set their own strategies and priorities for responding to the challenge of climate change;
- ii) Align behind the priorities developing countries have identified for themselves;
- iii) Be delivered in an efficient coordinated way, under the recipient countries' own leadership, and using country systems where that is appropriate;
- iv) Focus on delivering mitigation and adaptation results that are able to be measured, reported, and verified;
- v) Ensure that climate finance provided on concessional terms does not displace private-sector investment.
