CMP mandate from Cancun

- Parties decided to include CCS in geological formations in the CDM provided that certain issues are resolved satisfactorily
- Modalities and procedures to be developed in 2011
 - To address the issues highlighted in Cancun
 - On the basis of submissions by Parties/observers and the synthesis of these submissions by the secretariat
 - Workshop on technical and legal issues to address how these can be addressed in modalities and procedures
- Secretariat to prepare draft modalities and procedures, for consideration by the SBSTA and CMP in Durban (Dec 2011)
