UNFCCC Climate Action and Support Transparency Training (UNFCCC-CASTT)

- Promote effective and universal participation and exchange of countries in the MRV arrangements under the Convention and the transparency framework under the Parties Agreement through a targeted, professional and comprehensive capacitybuilding.
- Contribute towards realizing the Sustainable Development Goal 4 defined in "Transforming our world: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development" by enhancing the technical capacity and/or resulting in improved and robust information and data that form as a sound basis to formulate and implement the sustainable development agenda.



Impact of Package 1:
Enhanced, enabling and conducive policy environment for the implementation of the transparency framework (policy direction)

Overall Impact: Efficient and effective participation in the transparency framework both at the national and international level

Impact of Package 2: Robust translation of policy direction into management and implementation decisions and actions

Scientifically and technically robust implementation of the transparency framework in a sustainable manner
