## **INFORMATION NOTE**

### **Opening of the Online Registration System**

#### **United Nations Climate Change Conference, SB 48 30 April to 10 May 2018 Bonn, Germany**

I refer to the United Nations Climate Change Conference to be held at the World Conference Center, Bonn, Germany, from Monday, 30 April to Thursday, 10 May 2018, and wish to inform all Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the Online Registration System (ORS) is now open for registration by Parties for their attendance at the conference.

The ORS is being opened to facilitate the timely processing of nominations, compilation and organization of delegations.

The formal notification on the above-mentioned sessions and the corresponding agenda will be issued in due course, in accordance with the draft rules of procedure being applied.

The ORS will remain open for registration for the sessions until the end of the Conference. Online registration is the only official channel for nominating participants for the sessions. The secretariat cannot receive nominations sent by any other method. The ORS is available at the following web address:
