INFORMATION NOTE

Transportation United Nations Climate Change Conference

Warsaw, Poland, 11 to 22 November 2013

This note aims to provide participants with transport information which is designed to assist in finding their way to the venues for the preparatory sessions and the Conference venue for the upcoming sessions of United Nations Climate Change Conference to be held in Warsaw, Poland from 11 to 22 November 2013.

Warsaw offers an elaborate public transit network of tram, bus, metro and urban rapid rail lines. Conference participants may use public transport free of charge provided they present the conference participant badge bearing their name. The badges will be distributed at the registration desk at the Warsaw National Stadium and are valid for use on buses, trains and trams serving the Warsaw region. The schedules put up at stops provide <u>indicative travel times</u>.

The city's trams and buses carry on-board electronic information displays backed up with voice announcement systems.

Warsaw is also served by several taxicab companies. The best way to summon a taxi is by telephone. If possible, participants may ask for the assistance in securing a taxi by asking a City Information Point attendant. Not all taxi drivers speak English. However a majority do and if in doubt, it is best to have the destinations written and shown to the drivers.

Important Information on Warsaw Bus system:

Markings of bus numbers/lines servicing a given stop are also indicated at the stop (<u>http://static.panoramio.com/photos/large/12961967.jpg</u>). A number of stops of selected bus lines are only on-demand stops. The line is marked as "na żądanie" (on-demand Stop), and the number surround is green (for day lines).

In order to board the bus at the on-demand Stop, participants will need to signal your intent to the driver early enough by raising your hand in an apparent manner.

There are timetables available at stops indicating times of departures, and listing all stops on the route. Temporary timetables, related with, e.g. diversions, are printed on yellow paper.

TO THE NATIONAL STADIUM- (STADION NARODOWY) VENUE OF COP 19/CMP 9

The venue of the Conference - Warsaw National Stadium - is reachable by trams and buses.

In order to arrive to the Warsaw National Stadium, the following trams or buses may be taken. The stop to disembark is the Rondo Waszyngtona stops.

Trams: 7, 8, 9, 22, 24, 25

Buses: 102, 111, 117, 123, 138, 146, 147, 158, 166 507, 509, 517, 521

Night buses: N02, N22, N24, N72

Additionally, the Urban Rail allows you to arrive to the Warsaw Stadium. The stop to disembark is the Warszawa Stadion (Warsaw National Stadium).

TO THE PALACE OF CULTURE AND SCIENCE (PAŁAC KULTURY I NAUKI) VENUE OF THE PRE-SESSIONALS

The venue of the pre-sessional meetings is reachable by trams and buses.

In order to arrive to the Palace of Culture the following trams or buses may be taken. The stop to disembark is the Dworzec Centralny (Central Railway station).

TO AND FROM THE WARSAW CHOPIN AIRPORT(LOTNISKO CHOPINA)

Warsaw Chopin Airport (Lotnisko Chopina) is located within a distance of 8 kilometers from the city centre of Warsaw. The airport can be reached by a few lines of the municipal public transport organized by Zarząd Transportu Miejskiego.

Trams: There are no trams from the Airport

Urban rail (Train): S2 (Szybka Kolej Miejska – SKM - Warsaw Fast City Rail) KML (Kolej Mazowiecka)

In the vicinity of the terminal there is the underground Warsaw Chopin Airport railway station. It can be reached by the following trains:

- S2 SKM trains from the Warszawa Śródmieście through Warszawa Zachodnia (Direct connection from the Airport to the Conference Venue National Stadium (Warszawa Stadion)
- Koleje Mazowieckie (marked as KML) from the Modlin station through Nowy Dwór Mazowiecki, Legionowo, Warszawa Wschodnia, Warszawa Centralna /Warsaw Central Station/ and Warszawa Zachodnia.

Four day bus lines and one night line reach the airport:

- Line 148 from Praga-Południe through Mokotów and Ursynów (the Imielin underground station),
- Line 331 from the Wilanowska underground station (it runs only on weekdays at peak hours)
- Line 175 from Plac Piłsudskiego through Krakowskie Przedmieście, Nowy Świat, Aleje Jerozolimskie (the Centrum underground station, Warszawa Centralna /Warsaw Central Station/ and Warszawa Śródmieście railway stations) and Plac Zawiszy,
- Line 188 from Praga-Południe through Trasa Łazienkowska (the Politechnika underground station),
- **Night line N32** from the Warszawa Centralna railway station /Warsaw Central Station/ (a night interchange point).
