MESSAGE TO PARTIES

Information on the True-up Period of the First Commitment Period of the Kyoto Protocol

In accordance with decision 3/CMP.10, the secretariat was requested to produce and make available electronically on 30 September 2015 and every four weeks thereafter until the month of the completion of the true-up period, the following information for each Annex I Party with a commitment in Annex B for the first commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol:

- inventory data for each year of the commitment period;
- total emissions over the commitment period;
- total quantity of units held in Party holding accounts, cancellation accounts, and the retirement account.

In addition, information on the total quantity of aggregated holdings in the clean development mechanism (CDM) registry should also be made available.

The secretariat has prepared and published the above-mentioned information on the UNFCCC website on 30 September 2015 and updated it on 28 October 2015. Considering that the true-up period of the first commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol has ended on 18 November, the secretariat wishes to announce the publication of the last report with the above mentioned information at:
