## MESSAGE TO PARTIES

### Preliminary Information on the True-up Period of the First Commitment Period of the Kyoto Protocol

As announced on 21 July 2015, the review process under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol for the last year of the first commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol (CP1) was completed on 10 July 2015. Consequently, in accordance with decisions 27/CMP.1 and 3/CMP.10, the additional period for fulfilling commitments of CP1 (the “true-up” period) will continue until 18 November 2015.

Decision 3/CMP.10 requested the secretariat to produce and make available electronically on 30 September 2015 and every four weeks thereafter until the month of the completion of the true-up period, the following information for each Annex I Party with a commitment in Annex B for CP1:

- inventory data for each year of the commitment period;
- total emissions over the commitment period;
- total quantity of units held in Party holding accounts, cancellation accounts, and the retirement account.

In addition, information on the total quantity of aggregated holdings in the clean development mechanism (CDM) registry should also be made available.
