MESSAGE TO PARTIES

Information from developed country Parties on the resources provided to fulfil the commitment referred to in decision 1/CP.16, paragraph 95

At its sixteenth session, the Conference of the Parties (COP) took note “of the collective commitment by developed countries to provide new and additional resources, including forestry and investments through international institutions, approaching USD 30 billion for the period 2010–2012, with a balanced allocation between adaptation and mitigation” (decision 1/CP.16, para. 95).

The COP, at its sixteenth session, also invited developed country Parties, in order to enhance transparency, to submit to the secretariat for compilation into an information document, by May 2011, 2012 and 2013, information on the resources provided to fulfil the commitment referred to in decision 1/CP.16, paragraph 95, including ways in which developing country Parties access these resources.

In the light of the above, and further to the message to Parties dated 12 January 2011 requesting the early submission of information and views (ODES/COP 16/10), Parties are invited to submit to the secretariat the above-mentioned information **by 1 May 2011**.

In order to produce the document in a timely manner and to facilitate preparation, it is important that submissions reach the secretariat on time. Electronic submission, either on CD-ROM or sent via e-mail, will facilitate the timely production of documents, as non-electronic submissions will require more time to process. It is preferable for submissions to be formatted in Microsoft Word 2000. Submissions by e-mail should be sent to secretariat@unfccc.int; receipt will be acknowledged. Parties are encouraged to identify their submission by its subject and mandate.
