First Meeting of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building 11–13 May 2017 Bonn, Germany

Pursuant to decision 1/CP.21, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the first meeting of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building (PCCB) will take place from 11 to 13 May 2017 in Bonn, Germany.

In accordance with decision 2/CP.2, annex, paragraph 16, the first meeting of the PCCB will be open to admitted observer organizations. Representatives from admitted NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Points must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. Once the Constituency Focal Points confirm the nomination(s), they should forward the registration form to the secretariat using the following email address:

The deadline for registration as an observer is **11 April 2017**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be in a position to process Observer Registration Forms for NGOs received after this deadline.

Please visit the air travel carbon emissions calculator at www.icao.int/environmentalprotection/carbonoffset/pages/default.aspx to calculate the climate footprint of your travel. Secondly, you are also encouraged to compensate for your climate footprint by cancelling the corresponding amount of offsets through UNFCCC's voluntary cancellation platform at www.offset.climateneutralnow.org. Should you be travelling by train or car, we propose that you compensate for your emissions by cancelling one Certified Emission Reduction (one tonne of offset) at the voluntary cancellation platform.

In accordance with the Conference of the Parties decision 23/CP.18, and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally, you are kindly encouraged to nominate women participants to attend the First Meeting of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building.
