First meeting of the Adaptation Committee Bangkok, Thailand 7–10 September 2012

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations that the first meeting of the Adaptation Committee will take place at the United Nations Conference Centre (UNCC) of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP), in Bangkok, Thailand, from 7–10 September.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to admitted observer organizations, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. Given space limitations, participation will be limited to two representatives by constituency.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the observer registration form for NGOs, which can be obtained from the Constituency Focal Point. Confirmation by the Constituency Focal Point is required on the form. The observer registration form should be sent by e-mail or fax to the UNFCCC secretariat using the following:

The deadline for registration as an observer is <u>Friday, 24 August 2012</u>.
