### Joint Workshops on the Framework for Various Approaches, Non-Market-Based Approaches and the New Market-Based Mechanism

## Bonn, Germany 7–9 October 2013

The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA), at its thirty-eighth session, requested the secretariat to organize workshops on (a) the framework for various approaches, (b) non-market-based approaches and (c) the new market-based mechanism, to advance the work of the SBSTA towards fulfilling the mandates provided in decision 1/CP.18. For efficiency purposes, these workshops will be convened jointly from 7 to 9 October 2013 at the World Conference Center, in Bonn, Germany.

I am pleased to notify admitted intergovernmental organizations that these joint workshops will be open to admitted observer organizations. Given space limitations, participation will be limited. Representatives from IGOs nominated by the Designated Contact Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for IGOs, which is attached as Annex I.
