Submission by Sudan on behalf of the African Group on: SBI agenda item 12 on the 2013-2015 Review

The Conference of the Parties,

- Taking note and thanking the co-facilitators of the Structured Expert Dialogue (SED), the Secretariat for facilitating the work of the SED from 2013 to 2015 and its subsequent SED Report released in May 2015
- Recognising the need to address climate change as articulated by Article 2 of the Convention
- Recalling Decisions 1/CP.16, paragraph 138- 139; 1/CP.17, para.6; 2/ CP.17 para 157 and 1/CP.18,para .79-91
- Recognising that reducing temperature to below 2C is achievable
- Acknowledges the need to increase the pre-2020 ambition to strengthen the Long Term Global Goal (LTGG)

Decides:

- To take note of the SED report
- To inform the SBI and SBSTA in accordance with Decision 1/CP.17, para 6 and stress the importance of the ADP being informed of the outcomes of the 2013-2015 Review
- Further notes that there continue to be information gaps, particularly with regard to means of implementation critical to address impacts of climate change as well as the ambition gap, in relation to the areas covered by the scope of the review under decision 1/CP.18
- To request the IPCC to ensure that a sufficiently low marker scenario can be assessed to be consistent with limiting warming below 1.5 C by 2100, to explore a full range of scenarios in its 6th Assessment Report and make them available before 2020
