Description of Requirement:

The secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) is seeking to establish a long-term agreement with a qualified vendor who can provide (i) daily shuttle services between the secretariat's premises in Bonn, Germany; (ii) shuttle services during conferences in Bonn, Germany; and (iii) other shuttle services as required.

Detailed specifications will be provided as part of the Request for Proposal, which will be issued after the closing date of this request for EOI.

The EOI should include a description of the company profile and details of relevant experience. However, such description shall be limited to 1-2 pages length. Please do not include copies of certifications at this stage. EOIs that do not contain the information requested for evaluation by UNFCCC may be rejected.
