Geographical coverage: Global

Summary: United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) is a leading global partner in initiatives to reduce vehicle emissions. UNEP will support electric mobility at global, regional and national level with a focus on emerging economies. Activities for the next 3 years include 3 regional assessments, 15 pilot country projects, 4 regional projects and a global toolkit, and activities will focus on electric busses, light duty vehicles and motorbikes.

Reporting: UNEP will report progress in E-mob at the UN Environment Assembly every two years as well as through reporting mechanisms of the Global Fuel Economy Initiative.
