Summary of the commitment: UN-Habitat launched the Urban Electric Mobility Initiative (UEMI)

with the specific objective of achieving the widespread adoption of electric vehicles in cities to reach a target where travel by electric vehicles makes up 30% of total urban travel by 2030. This is to be achieved by the complementary actions of City and National Governments (demand-side actors) and Industry (supply-side actors).

Time-frame: September 2014 – December 2030

Reporting: (i) Reporting biennially to the UN-Habitat Governing Council pursuant to Governing Council Resolution 25/4 of the 25th session of the UN-Habitat Governing Council (17-23 April 2015); (ii) Annual update to the Partnership on Sustainable, Low Carbon Transport (SLoCaT).
