President's high-level event

Progress in advancing National Adaptation Plans

Monday 14 November 2016, 10:30-11:30, room Mediterranean (side events & exhibits area)

The national adaptation plan process enables Parties to formulate and implement national adaptation plans (NAPs) as a means of identifying medium- and long-term adaptation needs and developing and implementing strategies and programmes to address those needs. It is a continuous, progressive and iterative process which follows a country-driven, gender-sensitive, participatory and fully transparent approach.

The COP22 President will convene a high-level event at COP 22 in Marrakech to highlight the central role of the Green Climate Fund (GCF) and other entities in advancing adaptation through the NAPs.

The President's high-level event will be as well an opportunity to celebrate positive achievements and to share new initiatives.

Approach

The President's high-level event will be chaired by the President of COP 22, CMP 12 and CMA 1, Mr. Salaheddine Mezouar, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Morocco.

Brief scene-setting remarks by high-level panelists will help launch an interactive exchange of experiences, achievements and initiatives. This exchange will provide an opportunity to participants to interact from the floor. In closing the event, panelists will share their reflections based on the previous exchange.

The President's high-level event will take place on Monday 14 November 2016 (10:30-11:30, room Mediterranean). The event will be open to observers.
