**Draft conclusions proposed by the co-chairs of the contact group
on agenda item 3 (e)**

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) considered ways of providing expert review teams with access to confidential inventory information of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention during periods when the team is neither in the country under review nor at the offices of the secretariat. The SBSTA decided to recommend a decision on this matter (FCCC/SBSTA/2004/L.7/Add.1) for adoption by the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its tenth session, including a draft decision to be forwarded to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its first session.
2. The SBSTA considered text to incorporate the modalities and procedures for afforestation and reforestation project activities under the clean development mechanism agreed in decision 19/CP.9 into the relevant sections of the guidelines under Articles 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol. The SBSTA decided to recommend a decision on this matter (FCCC/SBSTA/2004/L.7/Add.2) for adoption by the COP at its tenth session.
