SUBMISSION FROM TURKEY

With reference to the document FCCC/SBSTA/2003/INF.9, entitled "Review of methodological work under the Convention and the Kyoto Protocol", dated 27 October 2003, the Ministry of Environment and Forestry has the following observations:

Among the four options presented in the report, the first one, although less costly to establish, may present difficulties for the interested persons in practice, since it relies on the external data sources which might impose restrictions and/or fees for access. Consequently, the other three options presented in the report are considered to be easier and more reliable options for accessing data sources.
