Compilation and synthesis of initial national communications

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) took note of the sixth compilation and synthesis of initial national communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (non-Annex I Parties) contained in document FCCC/SBI/2005/18 and Add.1–6.
- 2. The SBI noted that, based on the information contained in the above-mentioned document, non-Annex I Parties are continuing to fulfil their commitments under Article 4, paragraph 1, and Article 12, paragraph 1, of the Convention.
- 3. The SBI invited Parties to submit to the secretariat, by 13 February 2006, their views on document FCCC/SBI/2005/18 and Add.1–6 for compilation in a miscellaneous document.
- 4. The SBI concluded it will consider the sixth compilation and synthesis of initial national communications from non-Annex I Parties and the above-mentioned miscellaneous document at its twenty-fourth session (May 2006) with a possibility of preparing a draft decision on this matter for adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twelfth session (November 2006).
- 5. The SBI noted its request under agenda item 4 (a) to the Consultative Group of Experts on National Communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (CGE), relating to the CGE's examination of initial national communications, to consider the information contained in document FCCC/SBI/2005/18 and Add.1–6 and in the miscellaneous document referred to in paragraph 3.
- 6. The SBI welcomed the progress made by non-Annex I Parties in the preparation of their national communications, as reflected in document FCCC/SBI/2005/18 and Add.1–6, and noted with satisfaction that 129 non-Annex I Parties had so far submitted their initial national communications. The SBI encouraged those Parties that have yet to submit their initial national communications to do so as soon as possible.
