Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of the information contained in documents FCCC/SBSTA/2005/MISC.9 and Add. 1–2 and FCCC/SBSTA/2005/INF.7.
2. The SBSTA noted with appreciation the report by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) on progress made with respect to the development of methods to estimate and report on harvested wood products in the context of the preparation of the *2006 IPCC Guidelines for National Greenhouse Gas Inventories*.
3. The SBSTA decided to continue the consideration of this item at its twenty-fourth (May 2006) and twenty-fifth (November 2006) sessions.
