Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of the annual report of the administrator of the international transaction log (ITL) for 2005 (FCCC/KP/CMP/2005/5) and welcomed the progress reported on the development of the ITL.
2. The SBSTA agreed to recommend a draft decision on guidance relating to registry systems under Article 7, paragraph 4, of the Kyoto Protocol (FCCC/SBSTA/2004/L.20/Add.1) for adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its first session.
