接纳观察员组织

接纳观察员：申请接纳为观察员的组织

秘书处的说明*

1. 接纳政府间组织和非政府组织为缔约方会议届会的观察员，须依照《公约》第七条第 6 款的规定，该条款除其他外规定，“任何在本公约所涉事项上具备资格的团体或机构，不管其为国家或国际的、政府或非政府的，经通知秘书处其愿意作为观察员出席缔约方会议的某届会议，均可予以接纳，除非出席的缔约方至少三分之一反对”。
2. 缔约方会议第一届会议商定，秘书处应邀请本届会议及今后届会所接纳的所有政府间组织和非政府组织参加缔约方会议及其附属机构今后的各届会议，但根据《公约》和议事规则草案受到反对的任何特定组织除外。¹ 因此，秘书处依照目前适用的议事规则草案第 8 条向缔约方会议前几届会议所接纳的所有组织(仅被接纳参加某一届会议的组织除外)通知了缔约方会议第十六届会议事宜，但这不影响缔约方会议可能作出的决定。只是新申请参加届会的组织需经过接纳程序。
3. 秘书处编写了一份新提出申请的政府间组织和非政府组织名单，供缔约方会议审议，这些组织符合《公约》和目前适用的议事规则草案规定的要求及惯例，

而且表示希望派代表作为观察员出席缔约方会议及其附属机构的届会(见附件)。秘书处建议，“国家可持续发展咨询委员会”组织应仅接纳为第十六届缔约方会议的观察员组织，如果该组织希望继续参与该进程，应建议该组织在第十六届缔约方会议之后重新申请。²

4. 在草拟这份名单时，秘书处适当考虑了《公约》第七条第 6 款和目前适用的议事规则草案第 7 条和第 8 条的规定以及附属履行机构核可的既定做法，³ 即作为观察员的非政府组织须提供在《公约》相关事务中的能力证明，并确认其在联合国一会员国或联合国一专门机构或国际原子能机构成员国中或在国际法院一缔约国中的独立法人和非营利和/或免税地位。

5. 主席团成员已收到这份新的申请组织名单，对该名单所列组织没有提出任何反对意见。这些组织已被告知其被临时接纳地位，但有一项谅解，接纳这些组织为观察员的最终权力在缔约方会议。请缔约方会议在第十六届会议第一次会议上给予附件所列政府间组织和非政府组织观察员地位。

6. 同时也是《京都议定书》缔约方的《公约》缔约方不妨回顾第 36/CMP.1 号决定第 2 (c)段，该段就目前适用的议事规则草案第 6 条和第 7 条作出以下规定：

(a) 《公约》缔约方会议前几届会议接纳为观察员的组织，也将获接纳参加作为《京都议定书》缔约方会议的《公约》缔约方会议(《议定书》缔约方会议)第一届会议；

(b) 接纳观察员组织参加《公约》缔约方会议的届会和《议定书》缔约方会议的届会，将采用单一程序，《公约》缔约方会议就接纳观察员组织问题作出决定。
