Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) invited Parties and admitted observer organizations to submit to the secretariat, by 28 March 2011, their views on the implications of the inclusion of reforestation of lands with forest in exhaustion as afforestation and reforestation clean development mechanism project activities.

2. The SBSTA requested the secretariat to prepare a synthesis report based on the views submitted by Parties and admitted observer organizations.

3. The SBSTA agreed to continue the consideration of this matter at its thirty-fifth session.
