**Implications of the implementation of decisions 2/CMP.7 to  
4/CMP.7 and 1/CMP.8 on the previous decisions on  
methodological issues related to the Kyoto Protocol,  
including those relating to Articles 5, 7 and 8 of the Kyoto  
Protocol**

**Proposal by the President**

1. The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) continued its work on the implications of the implementation of decisions 2/CMP.7 to 4/CMP.7 and 1/CMP.8 on the previous decisions on methodological issues related to the Kyoto Protocol, initiated by decision 1/CMP.7 and further developed by decision 2/CMP.8, including those relating to Articles 5, 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol, and agreed to adopt a decision on the reporting of information on anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions by sources and removals by sinks from land use, land-use change and forestry activities under Article 3, paragraphs 3 and 4, of the Kyoto Protocol (for the text of the decision, see FCCC/KP/CMP/2013/L.11/Add.1).

2. The CMP advanced but was not able to conclude its work on other methodological issues relating to the implications of the implementation of decisions 2/CMP.7 to 4/CMP.7 and 1/CMP.8 on the previous decisions on methodological issues related to the Kyoto Protocol, including those relating to Articles 5, 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol. The CMP requested the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) to continue consideration of this agenda item at SBSTA 40 (June 2014) on the basis of the draft text available on the UNFCCC website.<sup>1</sup>

3. The CMP welcomed the timely completion of the work of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) on the *2013 Revised Supplementary Methods and Good Practice Guidance Arising from the Kyoto Protocol*, which was adopted and accepted by

the IPCC at its thirty-seventh session, held in Batumi, Georgia, from 14 to 18 October 2013.

4. The CMP noted the conclusion of the SBSTA that it will continue to consider, at SBSTA 40,<sup>2</sup> the implications of a possible revision to the eligibility of lands as clean development mechanism afforestation and reforestation project activities during the second commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol.
