I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The eleventh part of the second session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Durban Platform for Enhanced Action (ADP) was held at the World Conference Center Bonn in Bonn, Germany, from 19 to 23 October 2015.¹
2. The Co-Chairs of the ADP, Mr. Ahmed Djoghlaflaf (non-Annex I) and Mr. Daniel Reifsnnyder (Annex I), resumed the second session of the ADP by opening its 21st plenary meeting on 19 October 2015. They welcomed all Parties and observers as well as Ms. Yang Liu (non-Annex I), Rapporteur of the ADP.²
3. In order to advance the mandates and timelines agreed on at the seventeenth session of the Conference of the Parties (COP)³ and at COP 18,⁴ 19⁵ and 20,⁶ the Co-Chairs identified the objective of the eleventh part of the second session, namely to intensify the pace of text-based negotiation among Parties with a view to preparing the draft Paris climate package for presentation at the opening of COP 21.
4. Statements were made by representatives of 11 Parties, including on behalf of the Group of 77 and China, the European Union and its 28 member States, the Environmental Integrity Group, the African Group, the Alliance of Small Island States, the Independent Association of Latin America and the Caribbean, the BASIC countries (Brazil, China, India and South Africa), the Bolivarian Alliance for the Peoples of Our America – Peoples' Trade Treaty, the Central American Integration System, the Umbrella Group of countries and Indonesia. Parties made their full group statements available on the UNFCCC website, thereby allowing the substantive negotiations to start without delay.⁷
5. Statements were also made on behalf of the Presidency of COP 20 and the tenth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), and the incoming Presidency of COP 21/CMP 11.

II. Organizational matters

(Agenda item 2)

A. Adoption of the agenda

(Agenda item 2(b))

6. The agenda for the second session of the ADP was adopted by the ADP at the 1st meeting of the session, on 29 April 2013.⁸

B. Organization of the work of the session

(Agenda item 2(c))

7. Ahead of the 21st meeting, the Co-Chairs, with the assistance of the co-facilitators and the support of the secretariat and the Presidencies, released a non-paper containing, as had been requested by Parties, a draft agreement and draft decision⁹ and a draft decision text on workstream 2 of the ADP.¹⁰

8. At the 21st meeting, the Co-Chairs drew the delegates' attention to the above-mentioned non-paper, as well as to the scenario note prepared for the eleventh part of the session¹¹ and a document entitled "Further clarification on the mode of work of the session".¹² This clarification was prepared by the Co-Chairs following their extensive pre-session consultations with Parties. The organization of the work on agenda item 3 as clarified by the Co-Chairs included a contact group established at the fourth part of the session¹³ and spin-off group meetings on specific articles of the Co-Chairs' non-paper. The ADP proceeded on the basis of this proposal.

9. In addition, the Co-Chairs informed Parties of their intention to hold a special event with observers during the session. This event took place on 21 October.¹⁴

10. Other events and briefings held during the eleventh part of the session include:

(a) Events on 20 and 23 October on Parties' intended nationally determined contributions;¹⁵

(b) Briefing on 22 October on preparations for the 11th meeting of the Green Climate Fund Board.

III. Implementation of all the elements of decision 1/CP.17

(Agenda item 3)

11. The ADP considered this agenda item at its 21st meeting, as well as at its 22nd meeting held on 23 October. It had before it the documents referred to in paragraphs 7 and

8 above, namely the Co-Chairs' non-paper containing the draft agreement and draft decision, the draft decision on workstream 2 of the ADP, the scenario note prepared for the eleventh part of the session and a document containing further clarification on the mode of work of the session, as well as a note on the agreed mode of work at ADP 2.11¹⁶ and the report of the ADP on the tenth part of its second session.¹⁷

12. Throughout the session, Party inputs to the negotiations¹⁸ as well as the work of the spin-off group meetings were captured and made publicly available daily on the UNFCCC website.¹⁹ Two versions of the draft agreement and draft decision were published on 20 and 23 October.²⁰ The version of 23 October was also made available as an advance unedited version on the UNFCCC website. The final version of the working document was also made available on the UNFCCC website.²¹

13. In the context of work on workstream 2, including on how to further advance pre-2020 climate action, a technical paper containing the updated compilation of information on mitigation benefits of actions, initiatives and options to enhance mitigation ambition and its addenda on renewable energy supply and energy efficiency in urban environments²² were made available on 16 October. During the session, Parties exchanged views on workstream 2 in spin-off group meetings. The output of these meetings has been posted on the UNFCCC website.²³

14. On 19 and 21 October, the Co-Chairs convened stocktaking meetings to discuss the approach for the session. Based on those consultations, the Co-Chairs provided Parties with further guidance for work in the remainder of the session.²⁴ On 22 and 23 October, the ADP took further stock of the progress of work.

15. At its 22nd plenary meeting, the ADP had before it the work of the contact group dated 23 October 2015, referred to in paragraph 12 above.

16. Parties agreed to forward the outcome of their work contained in the draft Paris agreement and accompanying draft decision on workstream 1 and workstream 2 dated 23 October 2015 for further work at the twelfth part of the session. In preparation for the twelfth part of the session, Parties also requested that the Co-Chairs task the secretariat with preparing a technical paper.²⁵ This paper was to identify closely related paragraphs and duplications within sections, as well as possible areas for streamlining. Parties clearly stated that this paper be restricted to an editorial exercise to clean up the text without changing its content.

17. Closing statements were made on behalf of the Presidency of COP 20/CMP 10 and the incoming Presidency of COP 21/CMP 11. In addition, one Party made a statement available on the UNFCCC website.²⁶

IV. Report on the eleventh part of the second session

(Agenda item 5)

18. At its 22nd meeting, the ADP considered and adopted the draft report on the eleventh part of its second session.²⁷ At the same meeting, at the proposal of the Co-Chairs, the ADP authorized the Rapporteur to complete the report on the eleventh part of the session, with the assistance of the secretariat and under the guidance of the Co-Chairs.

V. Suspension of the session

19. At its 22nd meeting, the ADP agreed to the proposal of the Co-Chairs to suspend the second session and resume it in November 2015 in Paris, France, in conjunction with COP 21/CMP 11.

20. At the same meeting, the Co-Chairs expressed their appreciation to Parties for their work and support, and declared the second session of the ADP suspended.
