Draft COP Decision for 2013-2015 Review

The Conference of the Parties,

- Recognizing the need to address climate change under the Convention with urgency
- Recalling Decisions 1/CP.16, para. 138-139; 1/CP.17, para. 6; 1/CP.17, para. 157-167; 1/CP.18, para. 79-91
- Thanking the work of the co-facilitators and the Secretariat in facilitating the conducting of the SED from 2013 to 2015

Decides:

- To take note of the report of the co-facilitators of the SED to the SBI and SBSTA to inform the process under the ADP in accordance with decision 1/CP.16, para. 6
 - Further notes that there continues to be information gaps in relation to the areas covered by the the scope of the review under decision 1/CP.18, para. 79
 - Encourages the ADP to be informed of the outcomes of the 2013-2015 review
 - Reiterates Decision 2/CP.17, para. 167, that subsequent reviews should take place following the adoption of an assessment report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change or at least every seven years
