Draft conclusions

1. The Conference of the Parties:

(a) Recognizes that cleaner or less greenhouse gas emitting energy, emphasizing renewables, hydro, geothermal and natural gas, can promote global environmental benefits to meet the objectives of the Convention and the Kyoto Protocol and optimize the uptake of cleaner or less greenhouse gas emitting energy;

(b) Takes note of the offer from the Government of Canada to convene an informal meeting on the above-mentioned issue and invites the Government of Canada to report on the outcome of the meeting to the SBSTA at its fifteenth session;

(c) Invites the secretariat to convene a workshop on the above-mentioned issue, prior to the eighth session of the Conference of the Parties, the terms of reference of which shall be decided at the seventh session of the Conference of the Parties; and

(d) Invites the SBSTA to consider at its sixteenth session reports from the above-mentioned informal meeting and workshop, and to develop appropriate recommendations on this issue for consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its eighth session.
