



### Overview of reporting and review activities during 2006-2009

Reporting

(by Parties)



Review + Reports
(by ERTs)

- Initial report : deadline 1 January 2007 37 reports received by 1 March 2008:
  - ✓ Most of them received in December 2006;
  - ✓ Early submissions by Belarus, 31 October, Hungary, 30 August, Japan, 30 August, New Zealand, 31 August, Slovakia, 4 October, and

Switzerland, 10 November

✓ Late submissions by Bulgaria, 25 July, Canada, 15 March, Iceland, 11 January, the Russian Federation, 20 February and Romania, 18 May

√ Monaco 7 May 2007 (ratification 27/02/2006, entry into force 28/05/2006)

✓ New KP Parties: Croatia (30 May, 28 August 2007), Australia (3 December 2007, 2 March 2008)

- Annual report: deadline 15 April 2008
- Periodic reporting (NC4): deadline1 January 2006
  - ✓ Pending submissions by Luxemburg

- Initial review: 2006–2008
  - √ 37 Review Reports in 2007 and 2008 (decision 26/CMP.1 and 22/CMP.1)

√33 reports published, 3 under preparation, one review pending Belarus

✓2 new Initial reviews: Australia, Croatia

√39 + 2 Review Reports of the 2007&2008 Inventory submission under the Convention (conclusions by CMP12 and conclusions by SBI27)

39 Annual Review Reports to be prepared by 15
 April 2009 plus 39 Status Reports by June 2008

•Periodic review (NC4) and RDP review:

√ 38 Review Reports in 2007–2009

16 IDRs published, 10 reviews planned for May 2008





#### Establishing eligibility



- Eligibility to be established (decision 11/CMP.1)
  - ✓ No later than 16 months have elapsed since the submission of the initial report unless the Enforcement Branch (EB) finds that the Party does not meet eligibility requirements
  - ✓ Early eligibility: **not applied**
  - ✓ Status: 9 Parties are eligible as of 15 April, most are expected to become eligible between 15 and 29 April 2008
  - ✓ Eligibility status released from the CAD to the ITL and eligible Parties could perform transactions, e.g. on emission trading















- ✓ Party continues to meet the eligibility requirements for the purposes of maintaining eligibility unless the EB decides that the Party does not meet eligibility requirements
- ✓ Party may start annual reporting from the year following the submission of the initial report, on a voluntary basis
- ✓ 2008 inventory submission for Kyoto Parties is already the KP annual submission for Parties to maintain eligibility







## Meeting the methodological and reporting requirements

- **Decisions 15/CMP.1**, failure to meet the eligibility requirements
  - ✓ Party fails to submit annual inventory within 6 weeks from the submission due date
  - ✓ Party fails to include in the inventory a source category that accounted for more than 7% of the aggregated GHG emissions in the most recently reviewed inventory
  - ✓ Adjustments for a single year of the CP exceeds 7%
  - ✓ Adjustments for all years of the CP exceeds 20%
  - ✓ An adjustment for a key source accounting for more than 2% of the total GHGs in three subsequent years of the CP, unless assistance is requested from the CC







#### **Annual reviews in 2008**

- Review of the 2008 annual submission to be conducted in conjunction with the 2007 inventory submission (SBSTA and SBI 27)
  - ✓ Status reports prepared and sent to the CC no later than end-June 2008 (10 weeks)
  - ✓ In-country reviews for few Parties in September-October
  - ✓ Eight centralized reviews with 4-5 Parties for each one of the review teams
  - ✓ The review reports to be submitted after 22 weeks elapse after the review dates, but no later than 15 April 2009
  - ✓ Review of changes in the national systems and registry if reported
