

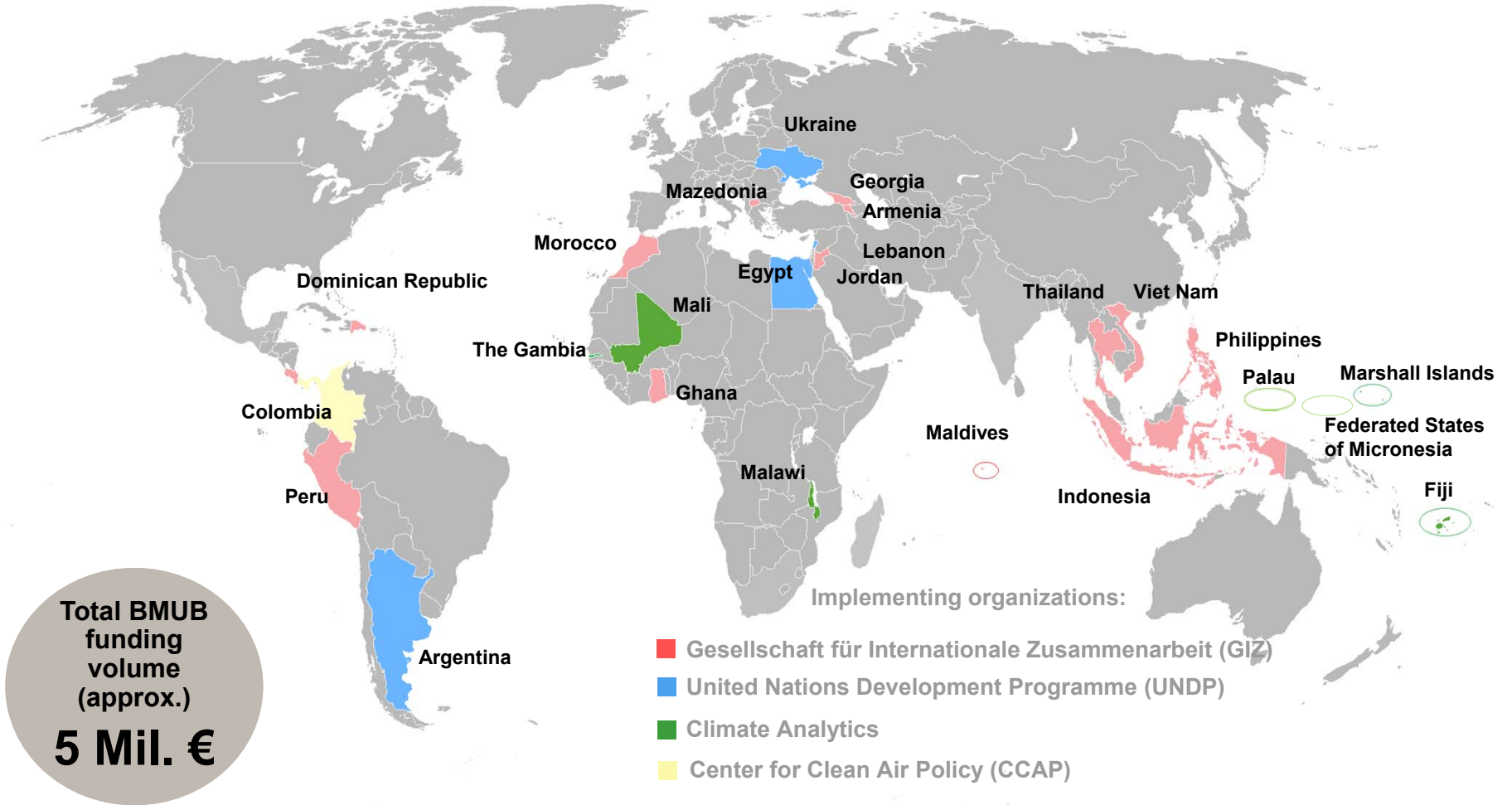

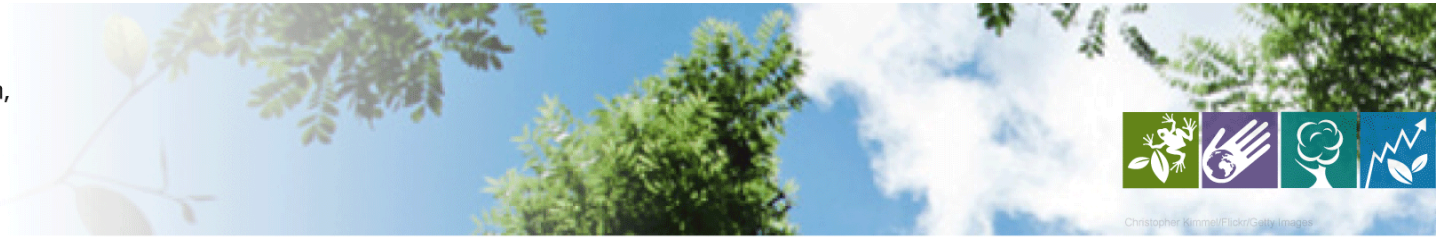

# German support for the preparation of INDCs via IKI funds

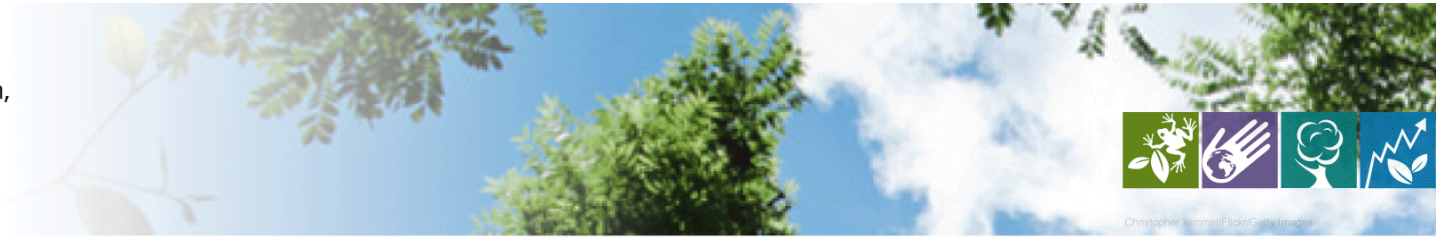


BMUB is also supporting the INDC-process in Partner Countries via multilateral cooperations, such as International Partnership for Mitigation and MRV (IPMM), Low Emission Capacity Building Programme (LECB) and the Partnership for Market Readiness (PMR).



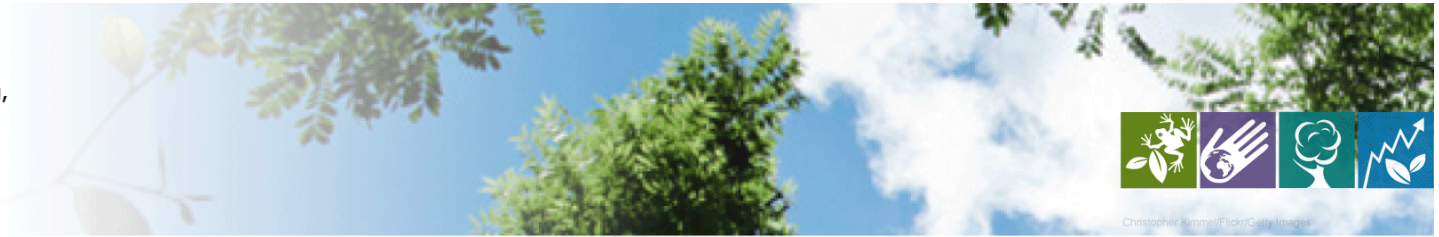
## Support provided to partner countries at national level

- Process facilitation and technical support for inter-ministerial agreement on mitigation goal, stakeholder consultation and for roadmap development
- (Technical) analyses and studies (e.g. on development of BAU, mitigation potentials, etc.)
- Workshops to embed INDC in LEDS, to operationalize INDCs as NAMAs, to establish MRV systems
- Supporting political decision-making processes for the submission of INDCs and the implementation thereof
- Foster (regional) peer-to-peer exchange and knowledge management



## Support for partner countries at global level

- Process Guidance (Study by Ecofys/New Climate Institute) on how to develop ambitious but feasible INDCs
- Stocktaking of planned and ongoing INDC processes for exchange between individual countries
- Foster (regional) peer-to-peer exchange and knowledge management
- Provision of general Terms of Reference for technical studies and analyses in individual countries
- Global workshop (4/2015) on lessons learnt, challenges and strategies to overcome those
- Webinars, conference calls on specific issues

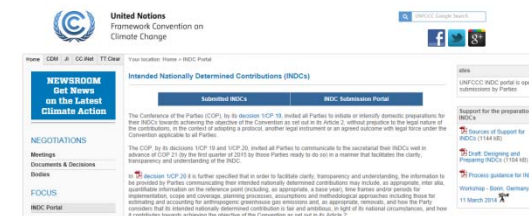
**Process guidance for Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs)**

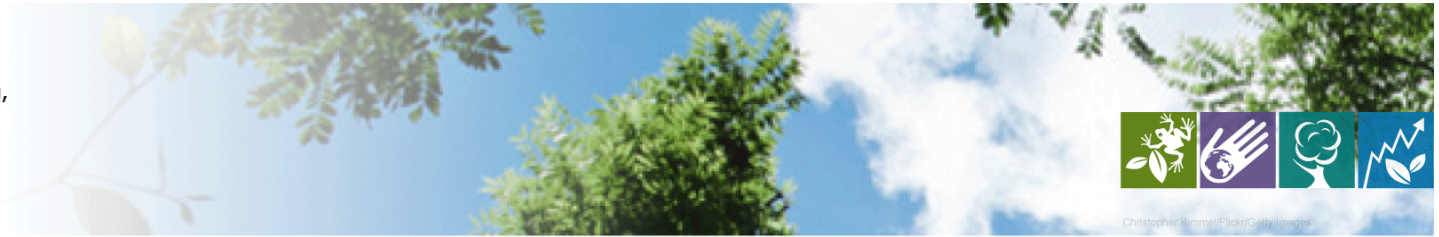


- **Objective:** assist countries in the preparation of their INDCs especially on how to address/select:

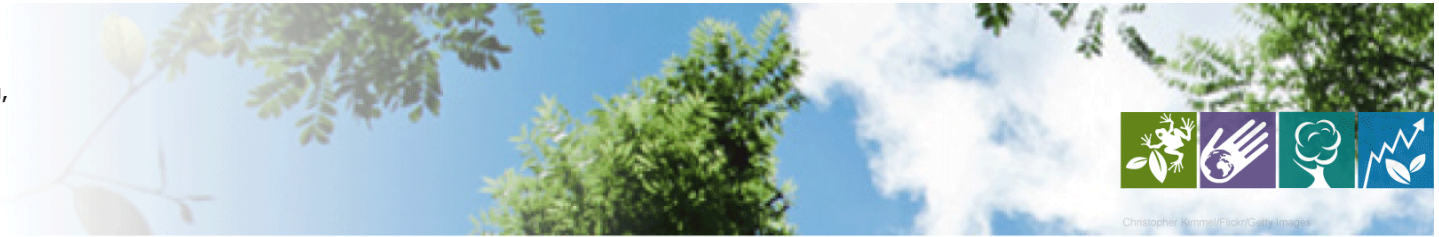

## Global Workshop on INDCs

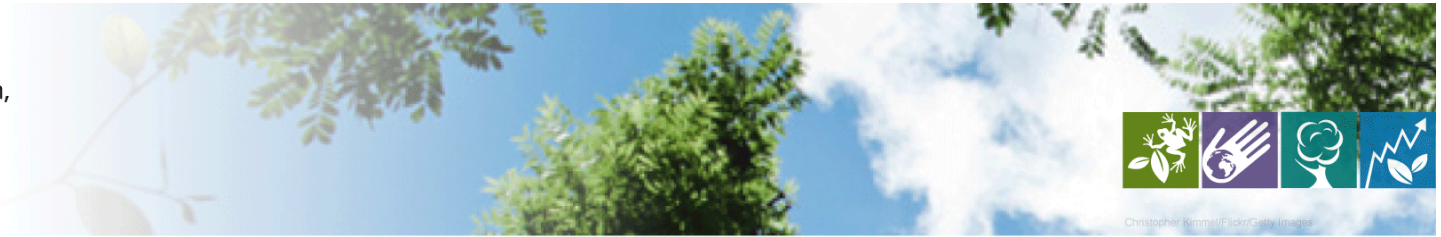
- 14-17 April 2015 in Berlin, Germany
- Organized by UNDP/LECB, GIZ in collaboration with International Partnership on Mitigation and MRV; IKI Programme Office and supported by EU KOM, Australian Government, BMUB
- Convenes government representatives and practitioners from partner countries as well as international experts that are involved in the design and preparation of INDCs
- Objective:
  - Exchange country experiences with the design and preparation of INDCs, including lessons learned, challenges and strategies to overcome those including between geographic regions



## International Partnership on Mitigation and MRV

- Supports national projects with knowledge management on INDCs
- Maintains a website on INDCs with background information on the international process, relevant documents, and country experiences

- Exchange of experiences and approaches between Parties in developing their respective contributions

- Contributes to UNDP Technical Dialogue on NDCs





## Further INDC activities supported by Germany

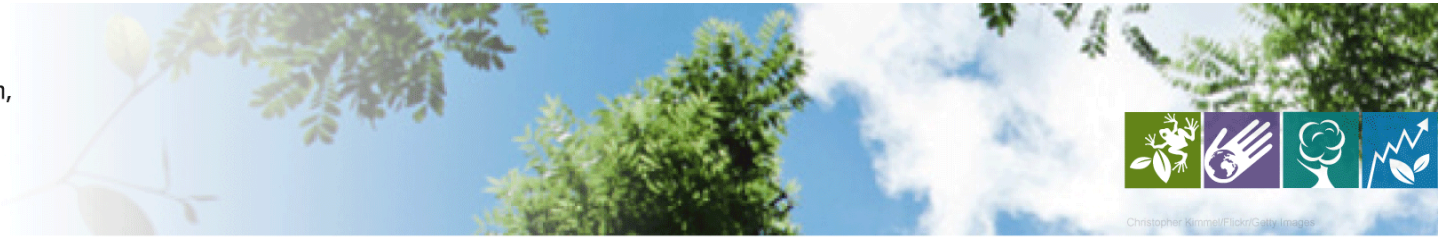
The **Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ)** has launched two projects to support countries in preparing their INDCs:



Activities are planned in a diverse set of developing countries, the aim is the formulation of a feasible yet ambitious INDC suitable to the national context:

- On a global as well as country-specific level, including major emitters and smaller African countries, **BMZ in cooperation with WRI** plans to support the process by developing policy frameworks, providing analysis and expert advice, and convening stakeholders.
- In up to 3 countries **GIZ, on behalf of BMZ**, will provide tangible INDC support on compiling information materials, conducting technical analyses, enhance capacity-building and promote political and stakeholder dialogues through workshops.
