Concept	Streamlining proposal (and paras. on which it is based)
Global goal on adaptation	<p>Streamlined proposal:  <u>[All] Parties [in accordance with the principles and provisions of the Convention, its Article 4 and their common but differentiated responsibilities [and respective capacities] and previous decisions of the COP]] [enhance adaptation commitments as a global responsibility], [agree]/[commit] to [take action towards the planet’s resilience to the impacts of CC] [cooperate to adapt to the adverse effects of cc in order to enhance resilience and protect ecosystems and people, their livelihoods and safety], as a collective responsibility by addressing the adaptation needs of all parties resulting from the global mean temperature increase given the implemented mitigation action [while recognizing the local, national and [international] dimensions of adaptation]].</u></p> <p><i>(Based on Para.50 opt.1, opt.5 and opt.11. Collective/universal commitments	<p>Streamlined proposal:  [Considering the urgency given that the effects of climate change persist even if emissions are to stop] all Parties [shall increase actions and cooperation to adapt to the adverse effects of climate change and commit] [have the obligation] to plan, act on and integrate climate change adaptation and [affect] [to implement] the objectives of the Convention in line with its Article 2.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Parties should undertake national adaptation planning processes with a view to integrating climate resilience into national level planning, [policy] and action in order to reduce vulnerability and strengthen governance and enabling environments.</li> <li>b. All Parties to base their adaptation efforts on best available science and knowledge, including traditional and local knowledge.</li> <li>c. All Parties shall involve, and facilitate the participation of relevant stakeholders in [national] adaptation planning [processes and actions which could include addressing local, national and global dimensions of adaptation thus contributing to sustainable development], decision-making and monitoring and evaluation processes, in particular women.</li> <li>d. All Parties shall give priority to the poorest and most vulnerable communities and people in their efforts to adapt to the impacts of CC.</li> </ol> <p><i>(Based on Para.50 opt.10, Para.51.opt.2 and opt.4.This proposal could result in deletion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence of P.50 opt.9)</i></p>
Adaptation component of INDC/ Nationally determined adaptation commitments /priorities/actions	<p>Streamlined proposal:  Parties [shall] <u>[are encouraged to] prepare, maintain, communicate and implement [a national determined adaptation commitment] [an adaptation component in their nationally determined contributions] [through their country contribution document], which may include, inter alia, their [upcoming] undertakings in adaptation planning, [synergies between mitigation and adaptation actions and economic diversification] taking into account [existing adaptation instruments available to each country so as to facilitate cooperation between parties and other stakeholders for their implementation and] the relevant guidance developed under the Convention [and following the processes and timelines for the development of [national adaptation plans] [national communications].</u></p> <p>Developing country Parties may further include in the [national determined adaptation commitment] <u>[adaptation component of their contribution]</u> an assessment of vulnerabilities and specific needs with regard to finance, tech and capacity-building in implementing their</p>

[The absence of national adaptation actions shall not be an impediment to eligibility for means of implementation].</p> <p><u>[The Secretariat shall keep and update an online registry of adaptation actions communicated pursuant to paragraphs 51 and 52 with a view to strengthening and enhancing cooperation on adaptation through the relevant institutions, mechanisms and channels under the Convention.]</u></p> <p><i>(Based on P.51 opt.6, opt.7 Para.58. NDAC: Communication and details of Cycle	<p>Streamlined proposal:</p> <p>The Secretariat shall keep and update an online registry of adaptation actions communicated [through the country contribution/commitment document] pursuant to paragraphs 51, 52 [the Secretariat will identify commonalities within the adaptation priorities communicated in NDACs and facilitate Technical Expert Meetings every five years], with a view to strengthening and enhancing cooperation on [and funding opportunities for] [implementation of] adaptation [actions] through the relevant institutions, mechanisms and channels under the Convention. The [NDAC] [adaptation component of their contribution] may be updated in light of national circumstances. [The governing body shall identify the modalities necessary for the communication, timeframe and operation of nationally determined adaptation commitments.]</p> <p><i>(Based on Para.51opt.6, Para.54opt.1. This proposal could result in deletion of P. 54 opt.2)</i></p>
MOI for adaptation	<p>Streamlined proposal:</p> <p>[Developed countries][Annex X Parties][All countries in a position to do so] should <u>[ensure [the provision of new and additional resources and] that the level of means of implementation for adaptation meets the adaptation needs of particularly vulnerable developing countries and]</u> formulate [adaptation support plans] [adaptation assignment of funds within their finance component of the INDC], including overall objectives, milestones, and sources of finance for supporting adaptation action in [particularly vulnerable] [developing countries][Parties not included in Annex X] in terms of finance, technology and capacity-building, to address the urgent needs of [particularly vulnerable] [developing countries][Parties not included in Annex X] [and ensure][ensuring] long-term support and [enhancing their support subject to the modalities and procedures to be developed and adopted by the governing body].</p> <p><i>(Based on P.51.6, P.51.7 (d); P.51 opt.10 and P.53 (d))</i></p>
Info knowledge, M&E to be reflected in Agreement	<p>Streamlined proposal:</p> <p>Monitoring and evaluation of, reporting on, and learning from plans, policies and programmes [should be a country driven and country specific process that would not impose any additional burden on Parties] shall be strengthened [and/or institutionalized].</p> <p><i>(Based on P.57opt.1 and P.61 opt.1. This proposal could result in deletion of P.57 opt.3.)</i></p>

Concept	Streamlining proposal (and paras. on which it is based)
Recognition of Loss and Damage	<p>Streamlined proposal:</p> <p>Parties recognize that inadequate mitigation and insufficient adaptation lead to more loss and damage <u>to which all Parties are encouraged to develop early warning systems and risk management plans, and communicate them to the secretariat by [X] as part of their national communications, in accordance with the modalities and procedures to be developed and adopted by the governing body.</u></p> <p><i>(Based on Para. 69.1 opt. (a). This proposal could result in deletion of Para.68)</i></p>

<p>MOI for Loss and damage</p>	<p>Streamlined proposal:  <u>Developed countries [and those in a position to do so]</u>, to provide technical and financial support to developing countries, especially to those that are <u>particularly vulnerable</u> to the adverse impacts of climate change, to address loss and damage to both extreme events and slow onset events.</p> <p><i>(Based on Para. 69.1 opt. (b))</i></p>
<p>Institutional arrangements</p>	<p>Streamlined proposal:  Institutional arrangements under the Convention shall be strengthened to support the implementation of the commitments related to loss and damage under this agreement.</p> <p><i>(Based on Para. 70.3. This proposal could result in deletion of Para.70 opt.2)</i></p>
<p>COP Decisions</p>	
<p>Strengthening of the WIM</p>	<p>Streamlined proposal:  The WIM shall serve this agreement as a process with modalities and procedures to be developed and adopted by the governing body.</p> <p>Developed country Parties and/or other Parties in a position to do so to support the implementation of the WIM through provision of finance.</p> <p>Based on the outcome of the 2016 review on its 2 year work plan, the WIM shall provide guidance on the implementation of a comprehensive approach to climate risk management.</p> <p>A technical panel is hereby established under the WIM on LnD.</p> <p><i>(Proposal based on Para. 70, Para.73 and Para.74)</i></p>
