INFORMATION NOTE

Pre-sessional meetings and workshop of the seventh session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP 7) and the fifth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action under the Convention (AWG-LCA 5)

The secretariat wishes to inform Parties, observer States and observer organizations to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and its Kyoto Protocol on the following pre-sessional consultations, meetings and workshop to the seventh session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP 7) and the fifth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action under the Convention (AWG-LCA 5).

- Presentation of document “Fulfilment of the Bali Action Plan and components of the agreed outcome”, by the Chair of the AWG-LCA.

- Presentation by the AWG-KP Chair of the notes that he was requested to prepare for the seventh session.
Friday, 27 March, from 2.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.
- AWG-KP workshop on issues relating to the scale of emission reductions to be achieved by Annex I Parties.
Friday, 27 March, from 3.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.
