Objective

- To use reporting as a management tool- questionable at the international level
- Knowledge sharing
- Facilitating learning
- Better understanding of the gaps and needs in what is working and what is not working
- Capacity building
- Communicate the message on the situation regarding the reduction on vulnerability and lessons learned
- Matching needs to sources of support



What to report

- Priorities
- Plans for adaptation (intentions)
- Status of adaptation actions
- Knowledge sharing component
- Existing modalities
- Links to vulnerabilities
- Internal processes
- The needs and gaps (guide external donors and governments as to where are the needs)
- Recommendations for future actions
- Means of implementation (financial, capacity and technical support)



Channels (tools for reporting) to be used for international reporting- the how?

- Existing reporting channels through national communications or biannual report - obligatory could also include reporting on the NAP
- NAP reporting (use the NAP itself as a reporting mechanism rather than reporting on pieces)
- Different views on the NAP process- the NAP could include everything mentioned on reporting including priorities, gaps and constraints.
- Modify existing channels of communication to accommodate adaptation reporting
- NAP Central
- INDCs



- **Constraint: Structure of existing reporting channels (NatCom and BUR)**

Solutions

- Looking at revising the current guidelines, including for the BUR, revision of the objectives
- NAP Central to complement existing reporting channels to provide more detailed information on progress, gaps and needs

- **Constraint: Timeframe for reporting on existing communication channels such as NatCom, BUR.**

Solutions

- BUR could be used to provide information on status, priorities and needs
- Engaging in ADP discussions on cycle for adaptation
