I. Mandate


- ❖ Secretariat, under the guidance of the Chair of the SBSTA, in collaboration with the AC and the LEG and with contributions from relevant Nairobi work programme partner organizations, including regional centres and networks, to develop case studies, as appropriate, that highlight good practices and lessons learned on the following, for consideration at SBSA 43:
 - Available and implemented tools and methods for adaptation planning processes addressing the four issues of ecosystems, human settlements, water resources and health;
 - Good practices and lessons learned in relation to adaptation planning processes, including on monitoring and evaluation, addressing the four issues mentioned above;
 - ➤ Good practices and lessons learned, related to processes and structures for linking national and local adaptation planning.




II: Overview

III: Work in progress and next steps

- Synthesis document in collaboration with the AC and the LEG (for consideration by SBSTA 43 in Paris):
 - Distill good practices and key lessons learned related to adaptation planning and actions at the regional, national and subnational levels, addressing ecosystems, human settlements, water resources and health, including linkages between these thematic issues;
 - Distill good practices and key lessons learned on structures and processes for linking national and local adaptation planning;
- 9th Focal Point Forum in Paris (focus on identifying and disseminating good practices from the case studies that help scale up adaptation actions at different levels)
 - Review group (members from the AC and the LEG and experts from NWP partners) set up to review and select case studies to be shared in the Forum;
 - The Forum to focus on criteria, any regional and thematic consideration for selecting good practices in addition to these criteria, and the type and level of information that needs to be documented and disseminated through an interactive discussion.
