



Climate Change Adaptation National level Decisions







National Adaptation Plan (NAP)

Background

- Lead: Environment Division with support from German Government
- First consultations:
 - February 2015 NAP kick-off and broader consultation on old climate change action plan (2007-2011)
 - Discussions between Environment Division and GIZ on overall approach
- NAP mandate from Cabinet (conclusion from May 2015)
- The NAP development will be aligned with updated CC policy and is foreseen to be completed latest 3rd quarter 2016
 - (aligned with TNA and SNC process as much as possible)
