- Transformational climate policies






Guiding principles










What the Partnership does





Overview on Findings from Preliminary Engagement

- Most partners stated that they are at the **beginning** of mainstreaming Climate Action;
- In most countries, the linkage between the ministry in charge of the NDC and the finance/planning/sector ministries can be strengthened;
- There is awareness, that NDC finance needs to be part of fiscal planning and budgeting. Financial support from partners and private sector is a top priority;
- Translation of planned actions into "bankable projects" is increasingly gaining interest: NAMAs and GCF;
- Some have progressed on creating/improving policy and legislative frameworks for climate change actions;
- According to partner countries, coordination (within government as well as with donors) around NDC/climate issues can be improved: have regular meetings, focus on substantial topics and obtain clear guidance from government entities.
