## About the Partnership

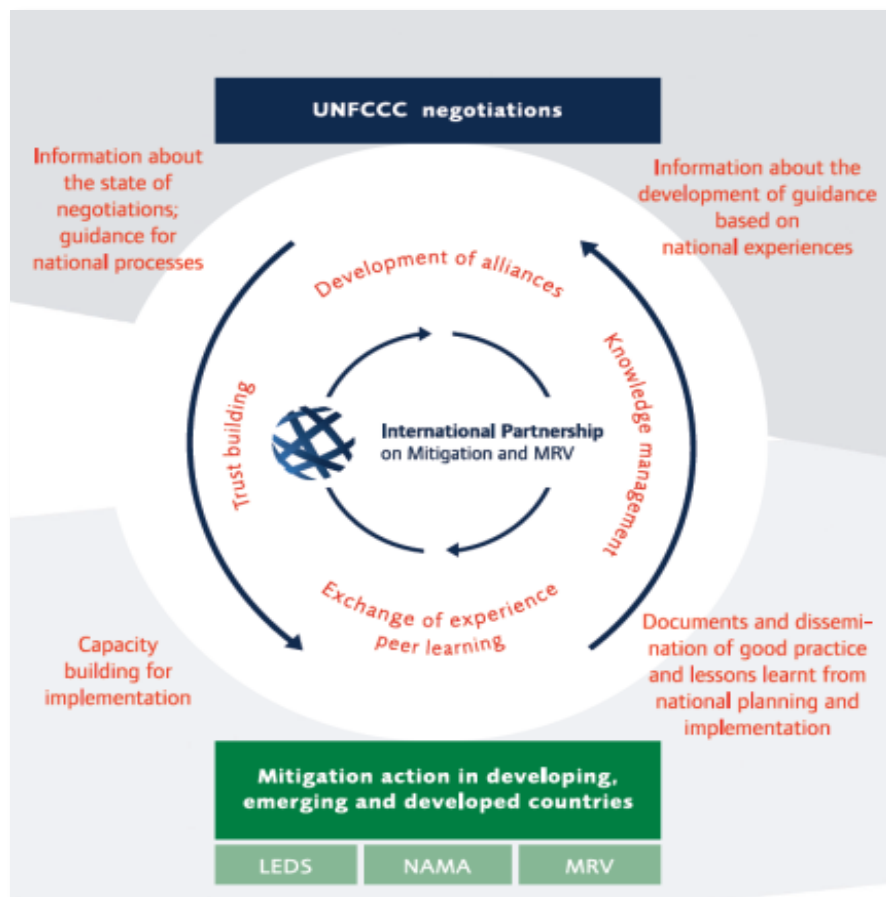
