Proposals from the breakout group

General observations:

Mapping of adaptation related mandates is a useful tool for identifying further coherence and possibility for synergies

It is important to establish functional relationships, division of labor, the modes of collaboration and time-lines between AC and constituted bodies to work, in particular where there is the explicit mandate for joint activities (e.g. relating to NAPs, MoI, NWP, L&D Excom)

A continued dialogue with international organizations, UN agencies, regional centres and networks with a view to establishing specific areas of cooperation should be further pursued.

The AC should continue assuming a coordinating role and identify strategic recommendations for COP on all aspects of adaptation and support



Proposals from the breakout group (based on AC/2014/18)

1. Technical support and guidance on adaptation action

Activities under this work stream are largely covered by the NAP task force, the TEC proposal for collaboration

Follow up on the regional NAP workshops for LDCs to identify synergies from which non-LDCs could benefit

Activities to enhance further collaboration with the NWP, in particular collaborating on the organization of the expert meeting on promoting livelihoods and economic diversification in Q3 2015



Proposals from the breakout group (based on AC/2-14/18)

2. Means of implementation (finance, technology and capacity-building)

Establish practical working relationship (e.g. a working group) with LEG and other CBs to work on organization of the workshop on Mol and follow-up activities

Provide input to the Durban Forum on Capacity Building at their future meetings

Seek synergies and identify time-line and mode of cooperation on work relating to the NAP process in a coherent manner (work on information document and joint AC/LEG workshop)

Continue and enhance dialogue with the GEF and the GCF



3. Awareness-raising, outreach and sharing of information

Continue to engage with the LEG on the further development of *NAP Central*

Make more use of the NWP's mandate to improve the relevance and dissemination of knowledge products in order to inform adaptation planning and actions at all levels

Other activities are covered by the Adaptation Forum group and by the Reports group.
