I: Background and context

Context: AC's mandate to promote a coherent approach to adaptation action under the Convention

3-year work plan requires the AC, after each COP, to:

1. Map mandates, workplans and/or decisions with adaptation relevance;
2. Compare and analyze maps in order to identify concrete activities to reduce duplication, address gaps and promote synergies;
3. Implement activities to reduce duplication, address gaps and promote synergies.

This updated information paper responds to activities 1 and 2.



II: Summary

Section 3. Comparison and analysis of maps to identify concrete activities to reduce duplication, address gaps and promote synergy:

Concrete activities through which synergies could be built and duplication reduced have been identified under all three work streams of the AC.

These activities particularly relate to work in collaboration or in dialogue with the NWP, LEG, TEC, CTCN, SCF, GEF, GCF and CGE.



III: Next steps

The AC may wish to consider the opportunities for collaboration as presented in the paper and agree on relevant follow-up action including:

- Prioritize areas for collaboration suggested in section 3 based on the expected impact versus required and available resources
- Agree on concrete proposals for collaborative activities and recommend to COP, for example
 - Collaborating with the NWP on the organization of the expert meeting on promoting livelihoods and economic diversification in Q3 2015
