Background

- ❖ AC agreed to convening a meeting, in 2018, to exchange views on national adaptation goals/indicators and how they relate to indicators/goals for sustainable development and for disaster risk reduction in the context of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015–2030
 - Under the Paris Agreement: a global goal on adaptation but no specified targets or indicators
 - ➤ 17 SDGs with 169 targets and 230 indicators, some of which are relevant for adaptation
 - Under the Sendai Framework: 7 targets and 38 indicators, some of which are relevant for adaptation

Meeting proposed to be informed by:

- Review of national adaptation goals/indicators contained in NAPs and NDCs
- Previous work by the AC on indicators in the context of M&E of adaptation
- Submission received under the NWP on indicators of adaptation and resilience at national and/or local levels or specific sectors
- Relevant work undertaken by UNISDR in the context of developing national-level indicators, the Inter-agency and Expert Group on Sustainable Development Goal Indicators and by other entities
