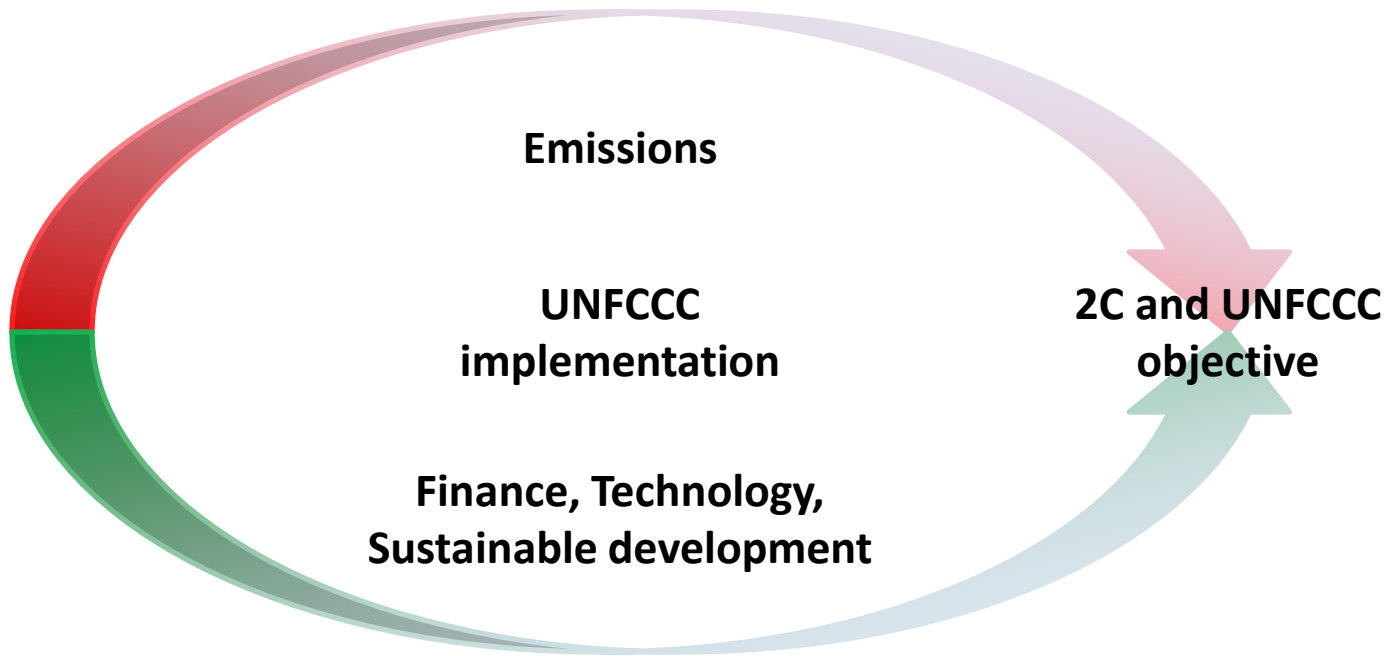

Paragraph 79, Dec. 1/CP.18

“assess, in accordance with the relevant principles and provisions of the Convention, the following: (a) The adequacy of the long-term global goal in the light of the ultimate objective of the Convention; (b) Overall progress made towards achieving the long-term global goal, including a consideration of the implementation of the commitments under the Convention”

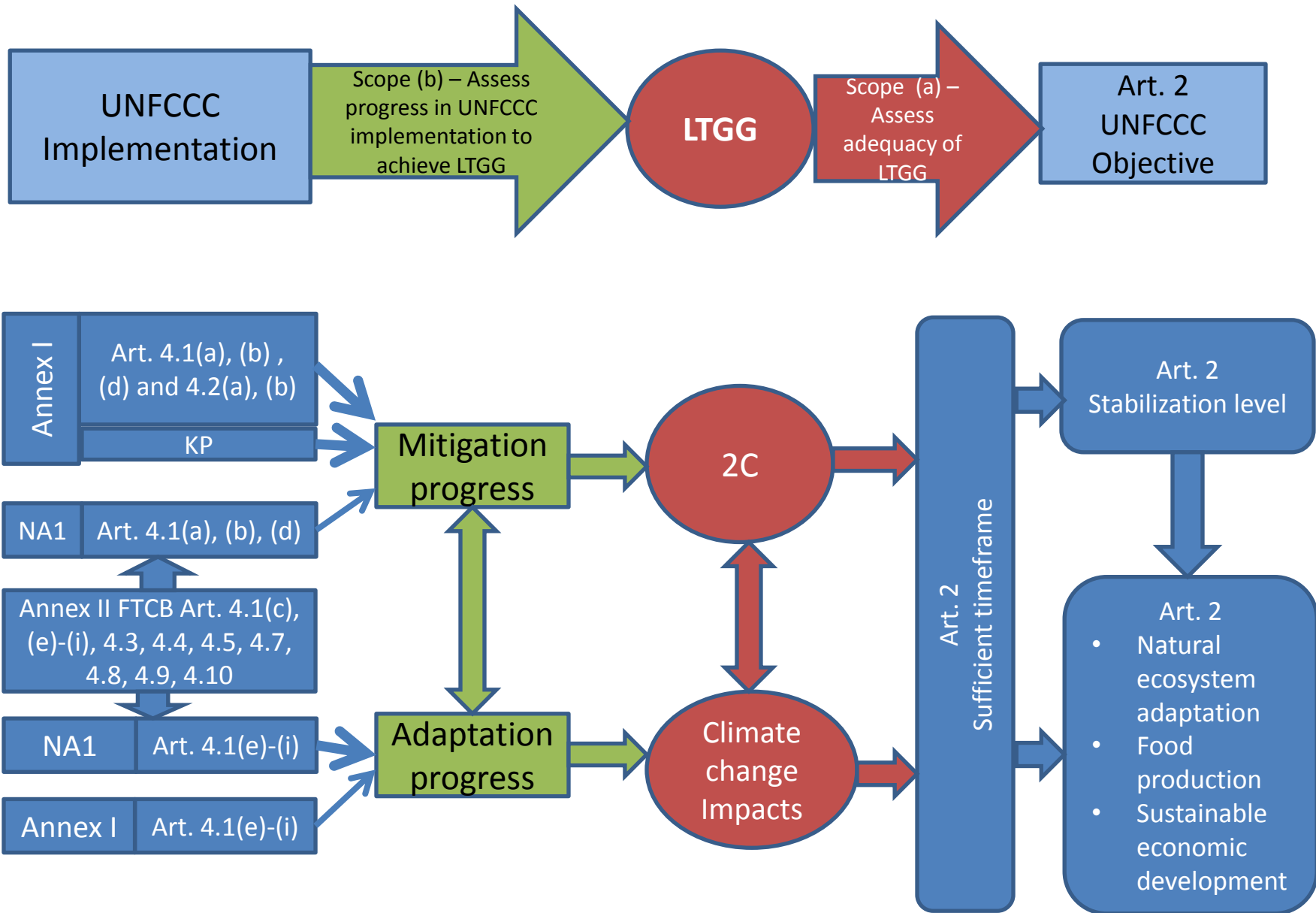

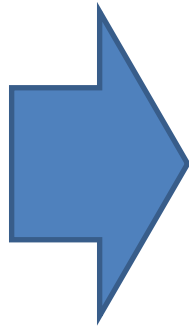

**Reviewing the implementation of commitments is the basis for assessing progress to and adequacy of the LTGG in achieving Art. 2 UNFCCC objective**

# Wide Range of Information Inputs

## Para. 161, 2/CP.17

“the review should be based on information from various sources, including the following:

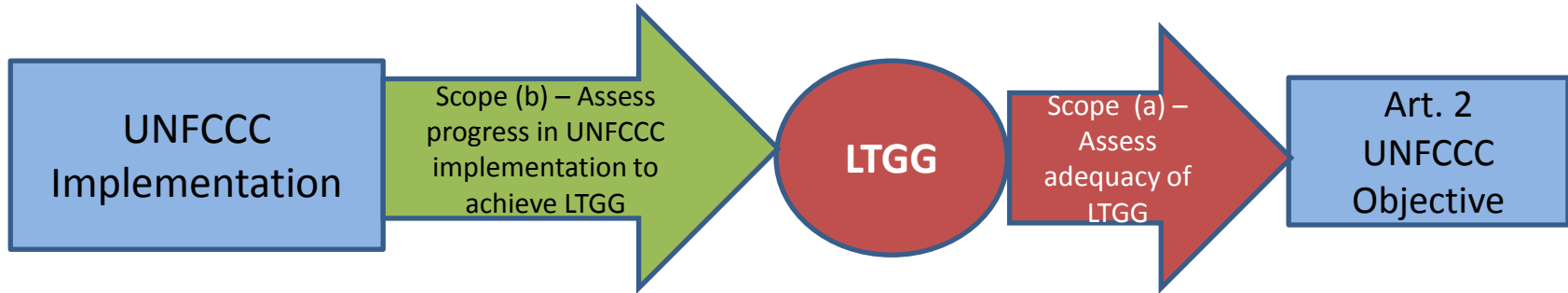
“(a) The assessment and special reports and technical papers of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change;

“(b) Submissions from Parties, national communications, first biennial update reports from developing country Parties and biennial reports from developed country Parties, national inventories, reports on international consultation and analysis, international analysis and review, and other relevant reports from Parties and processes under the Convention;

“(c) Other relevant reports from United Nations agencies and other international organizations, including reports on emission projections, technology development, access, transfer and deployment, and reports on gross domestic product, including projections;

“(d) Scientific information on the observed impacts of climate change, including that from reports coordinated by relevant regional and subregional agencies;”

## Integrated Contextual Framework for the 2013-2015 Review



Effectively assessing the adequacy of, and the overall progress to, the 2°C LTGG in achieving Art. 2 UNFCCC objective depends on reviewing overall progress in implementation of UNFCCC commitments in mitigation, adaptation, financing, technology transfer
