- ❖ COP 21 requested the LEG and AC to consider how they can provide more information on accessing funding from the GCF for the process to formulate and implement NAPs - the paper can contribute to responding to this mandate



## II: Summary

- ❖ Starting point for information gathering: list of countries that have already accessed or are in the process of accessing the readiness programme
- ❖ Sources of information could include:
  - ✓ Inputs from GCF and LEG
  - ✓ Complemented by interviews that could be conducted at SB44 (May 2016) and NAP Expo (July 2016)
- ❖ LEG, SCF and GCF to be invited to review draft
- ❖ At AC10, AC could consider the final draft, and any recommendations for the COP that could derive from it
