Subject: Thailand's Second Updated Nationally Determined Contribution

At the twenty-sixth session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 26), Thailand committed to fulfilling the long-term temperature goals set out in Article 2 of the Paris Agreement. In line with the global effort to keep the average temperature to 1.5 degree Celsius, Thailand sets targets of 2050 Carbon neutrality and 2065 net zero GHG emissions. Accordingly, Thailand's updated nationally determined contribution is revised with more ambitious target to pave the way to achieving such mid-century goals.

In accordance with Decision 1/CP.21 and Decision 1/CMA.3 of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), Thailand is pleased to communicate its second updated nationally determined contribution, as attached.
