Pp6	<i>Emphasizing</i> the importance of respecting and taking into account human rights, gender equality, the rights of indigenous peoples, intergenerational concerns, and the needs of particularly vulnerable groups, including women, children and persons with disabilities, when taking action to address climate change, as well as of aligning actions with the <i>goals</i> of promoting food security, <i>ensuring integrity and resilience of natural ecosystems including through restoration of degraded lands</i> , national health policies, participation in environmental decision-making by civil society and individuals, and a just transition of the workforce and creation of decent work and quality jobs in accordance with nationally defined development priorities and strategies;

Insert new paragraph	All Parties shall, in all climate change related actions, respect, protect, promote and fulfill human rights for all, including the rights of indigenous peoples; ensuring gender equality and

	the full and equal participation of women; ensuring intergenerational equity; ensuring a just transition of the workforce that creates decent work and quality jobs; ensuring food security; and ensuring the integrity and resilience of natural ecosystems.
Insert new paragraph	Requests the IPC to convene a workshop to facilitate an exchange views on the scope and content of further work on human rights and climate change to inform the implementation of the Agreement;
Insert new paragraph	Also requests the secretariat to prepare a summary of the workshop referred to in paragraph XX above for consideration by the CMA;

Para. 22	<p>Insert 22<i>bis</i>.</p> <p>Parties shall, when pursuing all mitigation actions, ensure they are consistent with all relevant obligations, ensure integrity and resilience of natural ecosystems, and respect customary and sustainable land use systems.</p>
Para. 29	<p>Insert 29<i>bis</i>.</p> <p>Also decides that the IPC, for consideration and adoption by the CMA at its first session, shall develop principles and guidelines for all actions in the land sector that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Ensure integrity and resilience of natural ecosystems; (b) Respect customary and sustainable land use systems and security of indigenous peoples' and local communities' land tenure; (c) Are undertaken in an equitable, transparent and participatory manner; (d) Ensure food security; and (e) Are consistent with all relevant international obligations.
