

## Points for ADP intervention

I am Indrajit Bose from the Third World Network, a member of Climate Justice Now!

- We are extremely concerned that goal posts are being shifted in delivering on the pre-2020 commitments by Annex 1 Parties;
- The work under workstream 2 is being seen as a 'talk-shop' where all pre-2020 action is merely about international initiatives – with no regard for the meeting of existing commitments which requires the urgent ramping up the ambition of Annex 1 Parties to close the mitigation gap; and in meeting the ambition gap on finance, technology transfer and capacity building for developing countries to enhance actions.
- The Green Climate Fund continues to be empty, despite it being ready to receive funds. Its urgent capitalisation must take place now.
- Real technology transfer not happening on the scale required.
- Postponing any real action to after Paris is not an option – not for the poor; not for the planet; the time for action is long overdue.
- Any talk of making contributions according to one's own national circumstances without any regard for science or equity is unacceptable;
- There is very little atmospheric space left for limiting temperature rise to well below 2 deg C, let alone 1.5 deg.
- The remaining space cannot continue to be occupied by those who have overused it historically and have accumulated their wealth;
- Equity, justice and science demands that the remaining carbon space is used fairly, taking into account the historical emissions of developed countries.
