I: Background and context

AC4 agreed on the theme, with the title to be further elaborated:

"Progress in the implementation of the CAF, with analysis of, inter alia, lessons learned, good practices, and challenges faced in preparing and implementing NAPs, the key role of national institutions and stakeholders in adaptation planning and implementation and monitoring and evaluating adaptation actions and their support"

The AC requested a small group to make the title clearer and prepare a concept note on outline, process, target audience and timeline of the report for consideration at AC5



II: Summary

Objective of 2015 Overview report: to provide a basis for identification of possible next steps to further enhance action on adaptation under the Convention - based on lessons learned, good practices etc.

Possible themes:

- Overview of the AC's activities over the first three years of its existence (the AC giving account). The report could follow the grouping in the workplan
