## Report Back: Breakout Group #1

Enhancing human, institutional and systemic capacities to design adaptation interventions in the context of NAPs and NDCs

## Key discussion points

- Ability to adapt climate models to national circumstances
- Establishment instead of identification of an already existing institution is more successful as it allows for a more focused work
- In policy planning and implementation, identification of stakeholders and approach them in an simple language to ensure their engagement
- Researchers and universities need to come together and propose innovative solutions to address fragmentation of information / climate change action



## Next steps (suggestions or a way forward)

- Identification of institutions involved in NDC/NAP implementation to assess capacity needs
- Bridging policy-plans and implementation stakeholders
- Bridging central and local governments
- Innovative measurement for capacity-building to reach a common goal
- Identify incentives for capacity-building: improvement of health, new opportunities for work, learning, promotion on the job within the organization
- Promote ownership: an individual, a youth club, a school, a department in a ministry can make specific commitments related to climate change and post the commitments on the web.
